World Environment Day [WED] was established by the UN General Assembly in 1972^[1] on the first day of Stockholm Conference on the Human Environment, resulting from discussions on the integration of human interactions and the environment. Two years later, in 1974 the first WED was held with the theme "Only One Earth". Even though WED celebration have been held annually since 1974, in 1987 the idea for rotating the center of these activities through selecting different host countries began.

Global warming, also referred to as **climate change**, is the observed century-scale rise in the average temperature of the [Earth's climate system](#), and its related effects. Multiple lines of scientific evidence show that the climate system is warming. Many of the observed changes since the 1950s are unprecedented in the [instrumental temperature record](#), which extends back to the mid-19th century, and in [paleoclimate proxy records](#) covering thousands of years. All these are due to majorly pollution by Human Beings to reduce the pollution we need to stop the Deforestation or we need to go for Tree Plantation.

Water scarcity in India. Water scarcity involves water **stress**, water shortage or deficits, and water crisis. This may be due to both natural and human factors. Main factors that contribute to this issue include poor management of resources, lack of government regulation, and man made waste.
