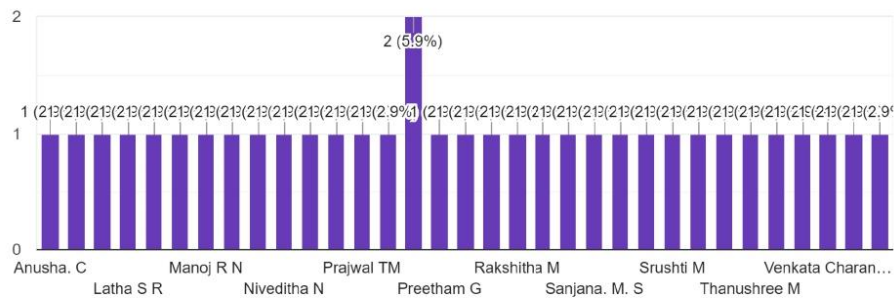
Key outcomes of the session:

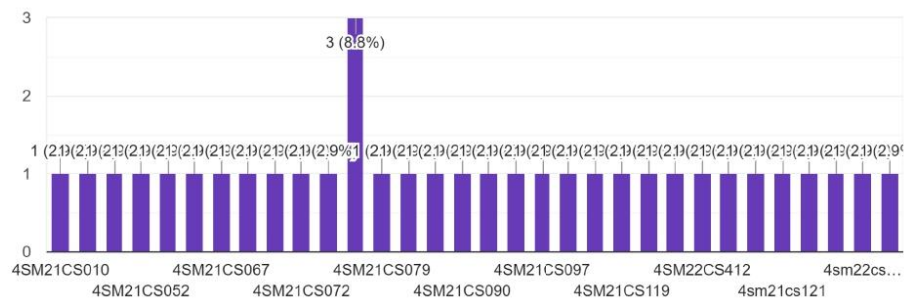

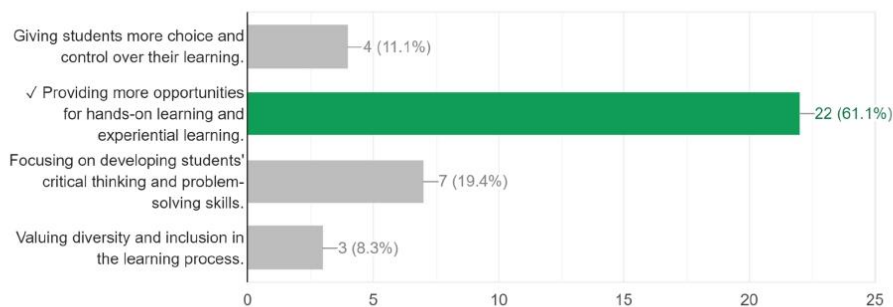

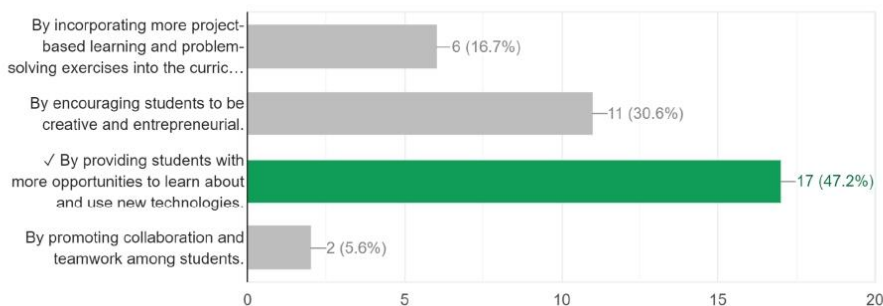
How can the NEP help us create a more learner-centric education system?

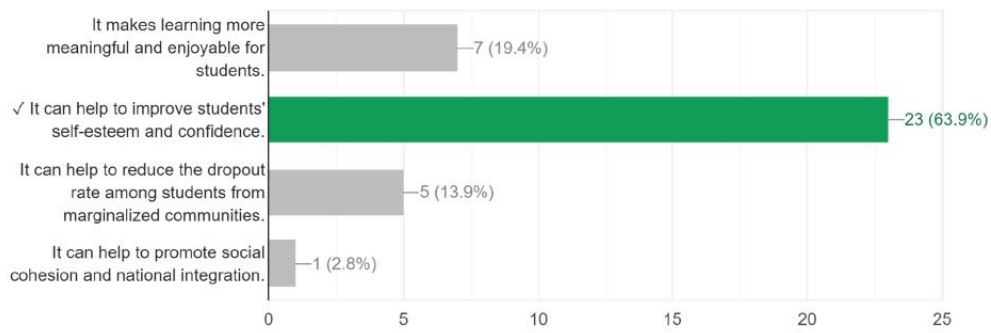
How can the NEP help us prepare students for the jobs of the future?

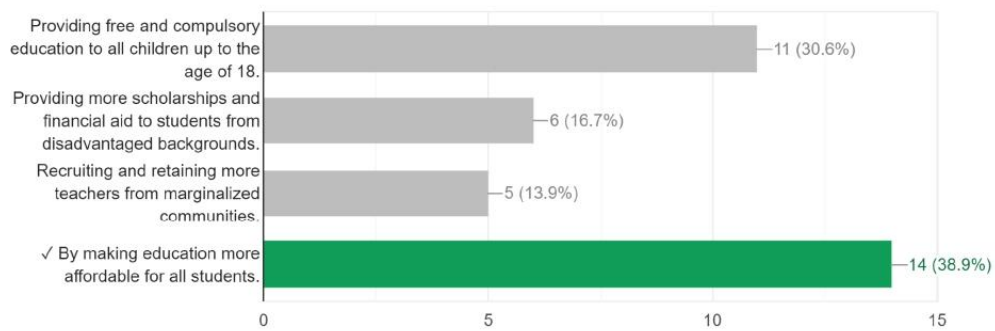
How NEP helps students to learning in their own language?
