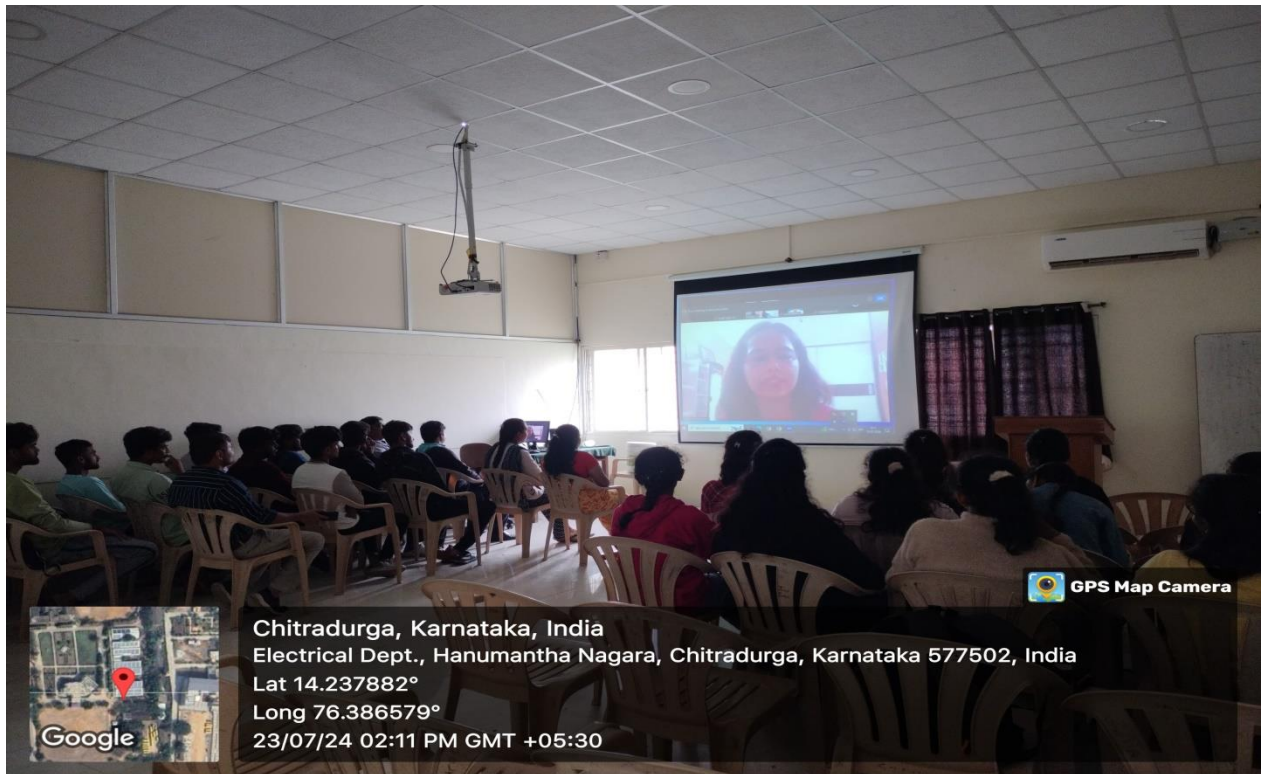
Brief Report of the Event:

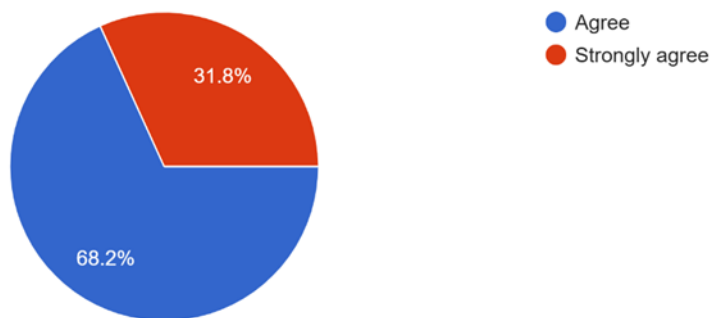

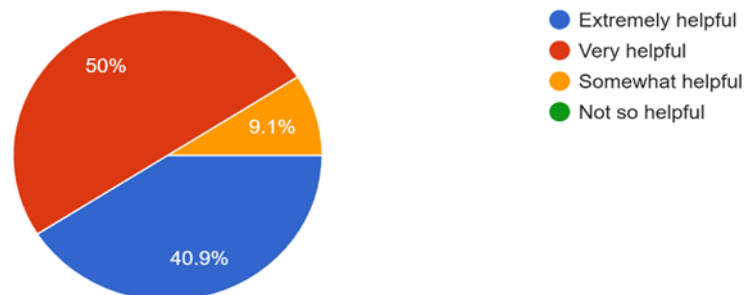
