4. The session sparked a strong interest in entrepreneurship among engineering students and faculty members.

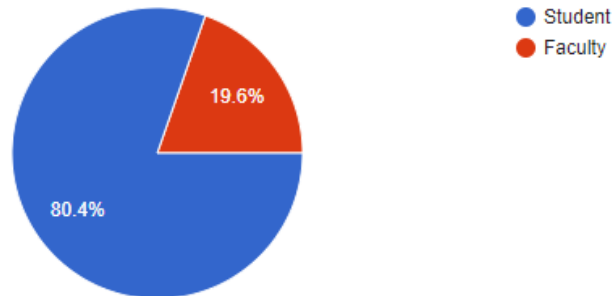

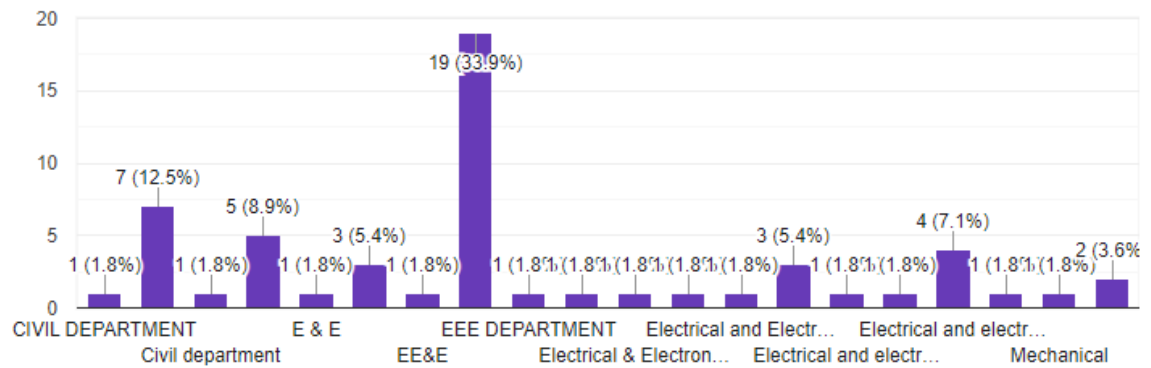

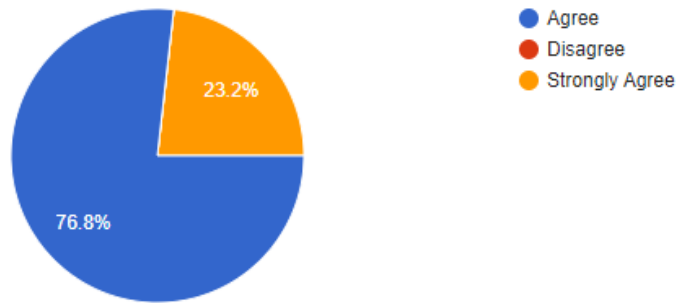

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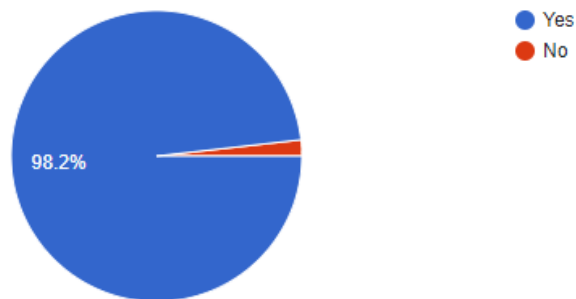

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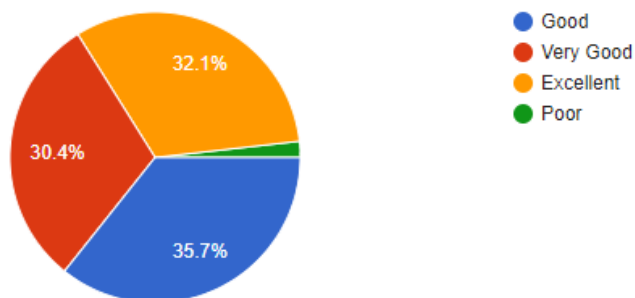

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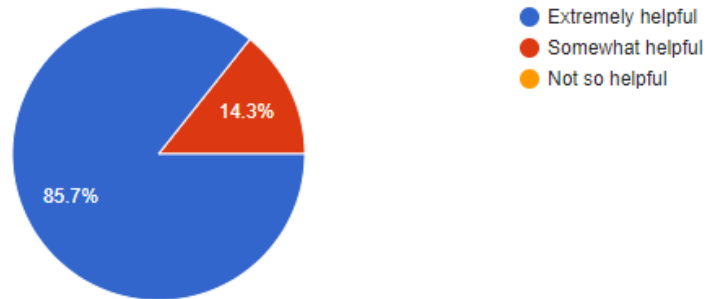

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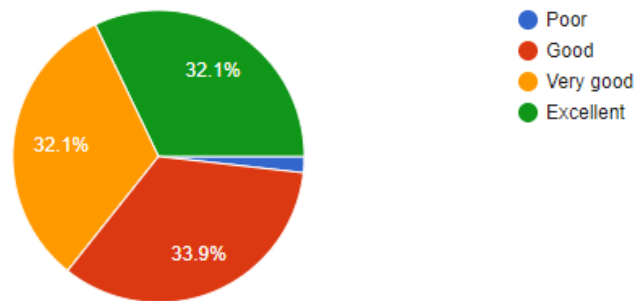
